

Alzheimer's Care Project Aging In Place(ACP) is an in-home assessment, treatment & management program for people living with Alzheimer's disease(AD) or related dementias.



The program is intended to provide assistance & comprehensive care to seniors living at home with AD & those who care for them over the course of their illness; to age in place with maximum independence.

ACP consists of 4 care issues:

- **Assessment:** Evaluate & document cognitive ability, skills & needs, home safety, ability to live alone, & caregiver capabilities with 2wk call & 3mo in-person follow up.
- **Treatment:** Develop treatment plans for behavioral symptoms, mood disorders, non-pharmacologic approaches, & need for Dr. referrals
- **Education & Support:** In-home disease education, workshops & support groups to improve quality of care & prepare for end of life decision making
- **Legal Options:** Create legal & financial plans including Advance Directives, Power of Attorney, Health Care Proxy & Long Term Care Plan.
